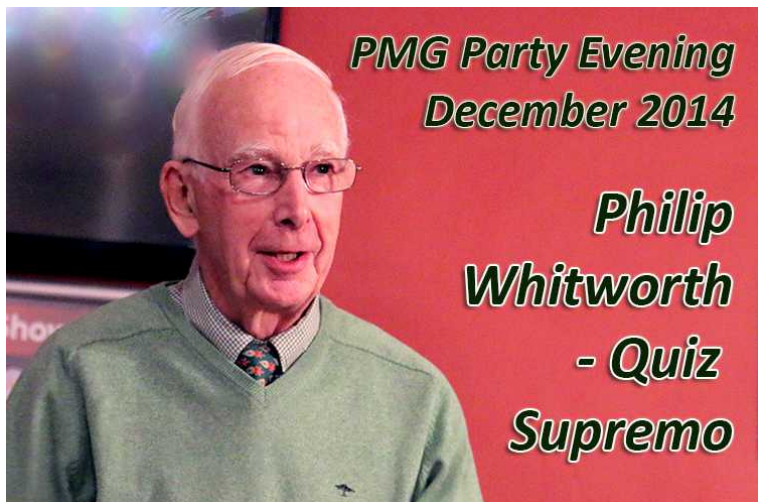


## Packington Men's Group PMG
