- Exhibitors are unlimited as to the number of entries in each class
- Entrants must provide their own vases, trays, receptacles etc
- ✤ All produce must be grown in the entrant's own garden or allotment
- Fruit, Pickles and Homebrew must be clearly labelled
- All classes in the baking sections must be done in the entrant's home kitchen and be presented on plain white paper plates only
- All place cards and exhibits must remain in position until 6pm
- All adult entries (except craftwork) will be sold at auction. Fruit and Veg can be swapped but must be approved by the Chairman prior to removal
- Any Challenge Cup awarded will remain the property of Packington Horticultural Society
- Banksian Medal "any competitor who has won the Banksian Medal in the past 2 years is not eligible to win this medal"
- Class 40-43 Must be in a glass bottle up to 1ltr with Crown Cork, Flip-top or Screw

Juniors

- Junior entry fee is free and Entries must be in the child's name
- All entries must be received within the allocated time frame late entries will not be accepted
- Class 80 & 88 Produce must be grown by the entrant in their own garden or allotment
- All entries in the junior categories must be the sole work of the entrant whom must fall in the correct age section
- ✤ All entries will be judged as per schedule requirements only


